## SCOPE FOR SEMINAR

The practice of utilizing the entire surface area of the lungs to deliver drugs into blood circulation has slowly transformed into reality as technological advancement. The growing demand for innovative drug delivery system will likely to create a market worth \$ 34.5 billion in 2010. Pulmonary delivery is effected in a variety of ways viz. aerosols, metered dose inhaler system, powders, and solutions. Aerosol products for pulmonary delivery comprise more than 30% of the global drug delivery market.



Research into lung delivery is driven by the potential for successful delivery of protein, peptide and genetic materials. It also appears to be a viable option for delivery of drugs through local targeting and systemic delivery for treatment of respiratory disease. Till recent years respiratory conditions such as pulmonary disease represented the sole therapeutic areas of the pulmonary sector. However, recent technological advancements have spanned the application of pulmonary devices to the treatment of non-respiratory conditions such as diabetes and migraine.
